Frequently Asked Questions

There have been questions regarding the new look of Phoenix Village Art Center's summer camp. Here are some answers:

1. PVAC summer camp looks so different! What is the same and what is new?

Same: Campers will still be creating their own wonderful artworks — drawing, painting, paper mache, printmaking, ceramics and photography — all the kinds of things they like to do.

Same: Children can attend 2, 3, or 5 days in the morning, afternoon or all day. The morning session runs from 9:00am until 12:00pm and the afternoon session runs from 1:00pm until 4:00pm.

New: Campers will be grouped by age and rotated through different media.

New: This summer every session has a theme, so each week of camp is different from the last. With a light dose of art history, each child can be inspired by a new thought, while having fun.

New: Each three hour portion of the day will be split into two 1 1/2 hour classes. Campers will breeze through the day going from one media to the next, exercising their own creative muscles.

2. When will the campers be creating artwork from clay?

Same: Campers will create ceramics projects on Mondays and Wednesdays every week of summer camp, in both the mornings and the afternoons.

Same: If you want to make sure your child gets ceramics, they need to be signed up for Monday/ Wednesday/Friday, or Monday through Friday. Children signed up for only Tuesday/Thursday will create a 3D sculpture, but not in ceramics.

3. Who is eligible to take photography and when is it offered?

Same: Children 10 and up are eligible to take photography, and it will be offered only in the afternoon.
