## New! Pre College Teen Camp:

Teens will meet in the evening from 5:00 until 8:00 during sessions 2, 5 and 8. Students who are interested in building skills and technique for entrance into art school will find this course invaluable. Students will construct a portfolio as well as get a head start on college level coursework. Interested teens are also welcome to participate in the Master's Program as a student or as a volunteer counselor for a school project or community service.

### 1. June 13 through June 17: **Preschool Creation Station**

Geared toward ages 3½ through 5. New this summer! Preschool is offered for 3 hours during session 1 only. This preschool is a playful approach to the world of art that opens the door to a love of learning. Build new experiences through stimulating activities. Media includes paint, chalk, and paper mache. Moms, Dads or caregivers can stay or go.

## Camp with the Art Masters! Ages 6 to 18

### 2. June 20 through June 24:

#### **Cubism & Evening Teen Camp**

Cubism began in France in 1907. Pablo Picasso and George Braque began creating figures that were made up of cubes, spheres, cylinders, cones, and other geometric shapes. The paintings looked like someone had cut them up and glued them back together.

### 3. June 27 through July 1: **Surrealism**

Surrealists wanted to free their minds of rational thought, to write or show the ideas that were buried deep in their minds. These artists did not wish for their work to make logical sense. This is why many of the pieces look like scenes from a dream (or nightmare).

### 4. July 4 through July 8: **Pop/Op Art**

Pop art, which embraces the images of popular culture, began in America in the 1960's. Artists created colorful images of the social figures, ideas and products of the time. Op Art is a math-themed form of abstract art, which uses repetition of simple forms and colors to create optical effects.

### 5. July 11 through July 15:

#### **Impressionism & Evening Teen Camp**

Impressionism is a style of art that began in Paris, France in the mid-1800s. It is called impressionism because the artists were not as exacting about portraying a realistic image. Painters used many short brush strokes, applying paint thickly, to create the idea, or impression, of a subject.

### 6. July 18 through July 22: **Tribal Art**

Tribal art will include art production from several small tribal communities all over the world. Unlike western art which is made for decoration, tribal art tends toward the functional. This means

that the art was used for a specific purpose like storing food, hunting or keeping warm and dry.

### 7. July 25 through July 29: **Dada**

Officially, Dada was not a movement, its artists not artists and its art not art. Dada was a literary and artistic movement born in Europe during the horror of World War I. People were so angry, that they undertook the time-honored tradition of protesting through the creation of non-traditional art.

### 8. August 1 through August 5: **Harlem Renaissance & Evening Teen Camp**

In the 1920's while African Americans in other cities faced race riots, many in Harlem were able to thrive in a supportive community. There had never been such a creative environment for black poets, playwrights, novelists, essayists, artists, and musicians in America.

### 9. August 8 through August 12: **Fauvism**

Fauvists (foe-viz-um) used exaggerated colors to express ideas and feelings. In fact, color was the most important aspect of a fauvist art, with the subject taking a backseat. Art critics accidentally gave them their name by calling them "fauves" which means wild beasts in French.

### 10. August 15 through August 19: **Abstract expressionism**

In Expressionist Art, the artist tries to express certain feelings about some thing. The artists that generated art in this style were more concerned with having their art express a feeling rather than making it look exactly like the subject.
